Tucked into a tightly knit and diverse streetscape of terraces, semi-detached homes and flats, Lambeth Cousin contributes a rich palette of crafted brickwork, concrete and folded metal. This is a familiar porch language within a distinctly contemporary home.

As a family home, the living areas are zoned into distinct, cellular spaces, avoiding the pitfalls of the 'too-big' open plan. Slices of light penetrate through reflective courtyards and skylights, defining spaces with light and ventilation. Skilfully resolved sliding doors reveal seamless connections to verdant courtyards. Designed for a family to remain in their beloved neighbourhood, this is a project that has a strong sense of obligation to its street and community.
